Bouncy castle (Kids Area):

For your little ones we have organized a great bouncy castle, please do not leave the children unattended here.

Box frame test:

Thursday from 11:00 a.m. you can test the Flyball-Box frames with your Team Boxes in Hall 2. Please use this time, we also have someone with tools on site should something not fit (contact our Information booth main entrance hall 1).

Bread roll service:

The caterer will be happy to take your bread roll order. Order forms are available at the information stand in the foyer of the main entrance. Orders must be submitted to the restaurant by 17:00 the day before and paid for in cash in advance.

You can collect the rolls from the restaurant between 07:15-07:30 on the following day.

Cocktails:

Our cocktail bar in Hall 2 is open on Thursday and Sunday evenings. Every evening there is a happy hour from 19:00-20:00.

Dinner:

Saturday evening from 19:00 the dinner will take place in the restaurant of the Hessenhalle. You will find the restaurant on the 1st floor main entrance hall 1.

Information-booth:

Our information booth is located at the main entrance to Hall 1 in the foyer. It is manned from Thursday to Sunday from 08:00 to approx. 18:00. Feel free to contact us if you have any questions, need help, etc.

Judges - Lounge:

The Judges Lounge is located in the "backstage area" (exit behind ring 1+2). Here all judges will be provided with drinks and food.

Kids-Area:

Between Hall 2 and Hall 3 we have set up a small Kids Area where our young guests can also have a great time. However, we cannot provide continuous supervision or be liable for the actions of the children. The duty of supervision remains with the legal guardians at all times. However, all children are welcome to come and have a look.

medical service:

During the day on Saturday and Sunday (09:00-18:00) there will be a medical service on site, which you can find in the foyer of Hall 1 at the information stand. At other times, please call the emergency number 112.

Merchandise:

Pick-up Wed/Thu/Fri 14:00-16:00 at the information stand in the foyer of Hall 1.

on leash area:

The entire area dogs must be kept on a leash (in your own interest, proximity to the highway).

One-way street:

We are planning a one-way system for teams entering and leaving the hall. The entrance for the participating teams is ALWAYS via the warm-up area in Hall 2. The exit after the races is always directly from Hall 1 or Hall 3. This is how we try to avoid bottlenecks.

open fire:

Open fires and barbecues are prohibited on the entire camping site due to fire safety regulations.

We have two official photographers on site, whose photos can be purchased by you after the FOWC. Private photographers please make sure that you do not disturb the tournament, if a judge or starter has a problem with taking pictures, you must refrain from taking pictures here.

showers:

The shower trolley is located at the back of Hall 2-3 and is open throughout.

tapework medication:

For the English teams we offer a vet check with worming treatment for the re-entry to England on Sunday evening. All teams should be informed about the details.

timeframe:

On Saturday, the races will start simultaneously in all rings every 10 minutes. Waiting for individual teams or missing team members is not possible here due to the tight schedule. Each team must have its own box and its own equipment for racing. Anyone who does not arrive on time automatically loses the race.

toilets:

We have a toilet trailer behind Hall 2-3 and the toilets in the foyer of Hall 1.

For your caravan chemical toilets we have IBC barrels for the disposal of chemical toilet and waste water tanks.

Vet-Check:

The vet check for participation in the tournament will take place on Friday from 11:00-17:00 in Hall 2. You can find the team schedule on our homepage or in your mailbox. Otherwise, a schedule will also be available at the information stand in the foyer of Hall 1 and in Hall 2.

A dog without a Vet-Check is not allowed to enter the ring or participate in the training or tournament.

Warm-up hall:

The warm-up hall is Hall 2, which is ALWAYS the teams' entrance to the rings from Hall 1 and Hall 3. The exit from the rings is always direct. In this way we try to avoid bottlenecks.

waste:

We have set up a large waste container at the back of Hall 2-3. You will also find large garbage cans everywhere. Please dispose of all your garbage from the camping areas in these garbage cans or the large container. (Please do not dispose of camping furniture, pavilions or similar large items).

water:

Collection stations for water are located at the toilet and shower trolley behind Hall 2-3.

Welcome ceremony:

On Saturday morning we would like to welcome all teams in Hall 1 country by country.

Please sort yourselves out early in the stands, we will place signs for you. There will also be helpers along the way to direct you. The ceremony starts at 08:00. Please make sure that all team members are in their seats on time. You are welcome to bring team flags etc. with you.

It will probably be loud and crowded, you do not have to bring your dogs with you, but if you would like to, you can of course do so. All teams will have enough time after the ceremony to get ready for the first races.
